JCS is resurrection of Life and GWTJ is the resurrection of damnation

2. The first resurrection and the second death are connected to Q1, respectively. How so?

First resurrection are all the saints. Completed at the point when everyone has received the mark (at midpoint). There is no more people to save.

Second Death is GWTJ

4. The judgment Seat of Christ pertains to conduct after saved, not unto condemnation, but for rewards/crowns. Identify the classes of reward and what is brought into purview

CLASSES OF REWARD

- There are different offices assigned to Believers. They include (1) Executive, (2) administrative and (3) Judicial offices.
- Executive — will get to reign with the Lord on his throne (Rev 3:21; 2 Tim 2:12)
- The Matthew 19:27-28 scripture reveals the judicial office — judging the 12 tribes of Israel
- The 1 Cor 6:2 scripture reveals another judicial office — the saints judging the world
- The parable of the pounds (Mat 25:14-30; Luke 19:11-27) each were apportioned one pound for trading.
 - The first gained 10 pounds were rewarded rulership over 10 cities (JCS account of stewardship-1 Cor 3:8)
 - The second gained five, they ruled 5 cities. Note, it is cities—Millennial reign (New Jerusalem is one city)
 - The third who gained nothing, refers to christian service. These do not use the spiritual gifts and abilities—slothful service that counts for nothing at the JCS—they have no rewards coming to them. They are saved, as by fire. (1 cor 3)
- The “many things” reward in Matthew 25:21,23 (10 talents, 4 talents and 1 talent) do not reveal are whether they were equal in both cases

WHAT IS BROUGHT IN PERVIEW

- One's service in ministry and the quality of that work rendered (not quantity) (1 Cor 3:12-13; 1 Cor 9:24)
- The Rom 14:10-14 (judging brother) pertains to conduct—living the christian life
- The good works we did as Believers. See Eph 2:10
- How you handle and receiving the God's people, and the message that God gives them to deliver (Matt 10:41)
- The deeds in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad (2 Cor 5:9-10)

1. Rapture
2. Judgment Seat of Christ
3. Marriage Ceremony and supper of the Lamb (dressed in white linen - righteous acts of saints - outcome of Judgment of seat of Christ)
4. Second Coming
4. Millennium reign
